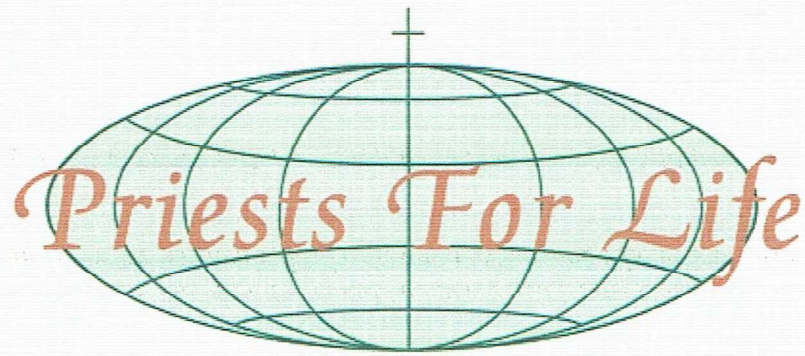

Thank you for your recent correspondence and for standing up for life! Please read the following comment from Priests for Life's Pastoral Associate Fr. David Begany concerning the Colorado Life Initiative:

'I have read both the pro-life initiative and the Colorado Catholic Conference's response. The Colorado bishops are making a prudential judgement by rejecting support for the pro-life initiative. They have the following concerns:

#1 The language of the initiative could be interpreted by the Courts or pro-abortion opponents as allowing for homicide charges against anyone who gets or provides an abortion.

#2 Since the Colorado legislature has failed to pass pro-life initiatives this initiative most likely, will not too.

#3 The language and tone of the initiative could be used by pro-abortion groups to get their own initiative passed (which is up for vote too).

#4 The Colorado bishops support another initiative that they feel will be more successful.

In summary, the bishops are making a prudential judgement about the worthiness of the pro-life initiative and they don't think it's a good idea. They are NOT saying that it is morally wrong to vote for it, just that's not a good idea, for the 4 reasons above. If one were to support the initiative and oppose the bishops' preference they would not be sinning because they are making a judgment based on their own prudent analysis.'
